

Player Code of Conduct

The Blackhills Football Club program exists for its players. We expect that our players not only try to perform at their highest athletic level in training and competition, but that good behavior and sportsmanship are displayed in all situations. Each player must affirm the following Code of Conduct.

1. A player must accept responsibility for his or her own behavior and performance.
2. A player respects the rights, dignity, and worth of each and every person and treats each equally within the context of the sport.
3. A player must have mutual trust and respect for his or her teammates and coaches.
4. Family, school, and spiritual obligations have a priority in the BHFC program ahead of training.
5. A player must adhere to all guidelines and rules as specified in the “Laws of the Game” by FIFA and never intentionally violate one of the “Laws of the Game” or exhibit behavior contrary to the spirit of the “Laws of the Game”.
6. A player must respect the integrity and judgment of game officials.
7. The Blackhills Football Club values the good health of its players and adherence to State and Federal laws. Players will not use or possess tobacco, drugs, or alcohol. Consumption of these substances on public or private property will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Violation of this rule will result in the immediate suspension of the player’s game playing and practice privileges. A hearing before the BHFC Ethics Committee will be convened as soon as possible to determine the consequences of the violation.
8. A player should display good sportsmanship in all practice and playing situations.
